



Categories of registration

The Australian Register of Naturopaths and Herbalists (ARONAH) will have the following categories available for membership:

1. Full Registration

To be eligible for full registration members need to:

- Hold the minimum acceptable qualification approved by the ARONAH Board for registration as a naturopath or herbalist
- Hold a current approved first aid qualification
- Undertake annual Continuing Professional Education (CPE) of at least 20 points
- Hold a TGA Exemption Certificate
- Hold professional indemnity insurance of at least \$1 million
- Be registered with an approved association listed in Schedule 3

2. Non-practising Registration

Non-practising registration is available to members who use their skills and knowledge as a health practitioner except for the provision of direct clinical care. It includes working in a direct non clinical relationship with clients, working in management, administration, education, research, advisory, regulatory or policy development roles, and any other roles that impact on safe, effective delivery of services in the profession.

To be eligible for non-practising registration members need to:

- Hold the minimum acceptable qualification approved by the ARONAH Board for registration as a naturopath or herbalist
- Undertake annual Continuing Professional Education (CPE) of at least 20 hours
- Be registered with an approved association listed in Schedule 3

3. Limited Registration

Limited registration is available to members who do not meet the eligibility requirements for full or non-practising registration but would like to develop the required skills to be registered. Applicants granted limited registration will be provided with a plan to address the particular skill deficits.
